Buy on bus

Smart (buy on bus or at shops - varies by ticket - using a **get me there** card or another compatible smart card with the ITSO logo).



Buy 7 day and 28 day AnyBus & Tram tickets online at **getmethere.com** using a **get me there** smart card only.

Using a smart card:

Touch-in at the smart reader, when boarding a bus.

Touch-in at a smart reader before boarding and touch-out at your destination stop, when travelling by tram.



Buy at TfGM Travelshops (as paper and smart tickets)



Buy at PayPoint (smart tickets only)

Terms and conditions

Bus

1 day (all day)/7 day/28 day: AnyBus*, anywhere in Greater Manchester. Valid anytime, any day of the week, including Bank Holidays. Valid until 03:59 the following day. igo needed for Junior products - igo is a smart card available from TfGM. Smart means you can load your ticket on to a **get me there** smart card or any other compatible ITSO enabled card. You can load on the bus, at TfGM Travelshops and some tickets are available at PayPoint.

Train

1 day (off peak): from 0930 to 1601 then 1830 to 0359 Monday to Friday. Valid all day at weekends and Bank Holidays to 0359 the following day. Train ID needed for AnyBus, Tram and Train and Train Tickets above 1 day.

Tram

1 day (off peak) From 09:30 Monday to Friday and all day at weekends and Bank Holidays. Any tram, anywhere in Greater Manchester. Valid until end of service. 1 day (all day) (get me there): Any tram, anywhere in Greater Manchester. Valid until end of service. 7 day/28 day (get me there): Any tram, anywhere in Greater Manchester. Valid until end of service.

AnyBus, Train and Tram Zone 1 7, 28 and annual - also known as County Card: Can be used in tram Zone 1 only (not wider tram network) which includes Cornbrook, Deansgate-Castlefield, St Peter's Square, Piccadilly Gardens, Piccadilly, New Islington, Market Street, Shudehill, Exchange Square and Victoria. A System One Travel photocard or Train ID is needed to purchase and use this ticket.

ID

Junior Tickets – you need an igo smart card to use to buy or as ID for paper purchase.

Young Person Tickets – you may be asked for a valid photographic age ID to purchase and use this ticket.
